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MILRINONE LACTATE - INJECTION

OTHER NAMES: Primacor

USES: This medication is used in the treatment of congestive heart failure (CHF).

HOW TO USE THIS MEDICATION: This medication is given by injection into a vein.

You will be monitored closely by means of regular doctor visits and routine laboratory tests to ensure the effectiveness and safety of this medication.

SIDE EFFECTS: This medication is generally well tolerated. Headache, chest pain and a slight fever have been reported as a result of this medication. If these effects continue or become bothersome, inform your doctor.

PRECAUTIONS: This medication should be used only if clearly needed during pregnancy. Discuss the risks and benefits with your doctor. It is not known if this medication is found in breast milk. Consult your doctor before breast-feeding.

Tell your doctor of any illnesses or allergies you have.

DRUG INTERACTIONS: Tell your doctor of any over-the-counter or prescription medication you may take.

NOTES: An oral form of this medication has been under study but does not show as great a benefit as does the injectable form.

MISSED DOSE: If you miss a dose, take it as soon as remembered; do not take it if it is near the time for the next dose, instead, skip the missed dose and resume your usual dosing schedule. Do not "double-up" the dose to catch up.

STORAGE: Store as directed away from heat and light.
